

RULES AND CONDITIONS

1. All entries must be made on the attached form (photocopies acceptable) and must reach the Secretary together with the correct entry fee by 23rd May 2018. Late entries will be accepted, if numbers permit, at £3 extra per class.
2. In the event of insufficient starters lower prizes may be withheld in accordance with Rule 76.6 (British Showjumping).
3. The Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without giving any reason.
4. The Judges decision is final.
5. Any objection must be made in writing to the Secretary within 30 minutes of the incident with a £20 deposit. The objection will be considered by the Chairman. The Chairman's decision shall be final.
6. Hard hats must be worn at all times whilst mounted, see also Rule 10.
7. Riders are reminded that the Showground is open to the public and caution should be exercised at all times particularly whilst moving horses/ponies between rings and practice areas. All such movements must be at walk. No lunging anywhere on the showground.
8. The Organisers accept no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury arising from accident or any other cause to any animal or person whatsoever.
9. All parking of cars or lorries is at owners risk.
10. The Organisers reserve the right to expel any person for any reason, without warning, and without refunding any entry fees.
11. All owners and riders (and where applicable their parents/guardians) of horses/ponies competing in jumping competitions at this show shall be deemed to be subject to the rules and regulations of the British Show Jumping (obtainable from the Secretary-General, British Showjumping, Stoneleigh, Kenilworth, Warwickshire) as though each of them were Members. Rules 81 & 82 provide for the conduct and discipline of Members.
12. Entries in classes 1 2 and 3 are confined to Registered Horses, ridden by Members in accordance with British Showjumping rule 79.
13. Class 1,2 &3 for registered horses to be ridden by full, associate or junior associate members excluding any rider listed on the BS gold league as of 30th June 2014 and any horse-rider combination listed on the BS silver league as of 30th June 2014. (silver league exclusion only applies to class 1&2) Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any senior international team (nations cup, world, European championships and Olympic games) are not eligible. Pony riders, children, juniors and young riders who have ever competed in nations cup/ international team events and European championships in the last five years are not eligible (excluding veteran and para teams) First six to qualify, qualification will not pass down the line and qualifiers must jump clear in the first round.
14. Junior members competing on horses are only able to so from the beginning of the calendar year in which the age of twelve is reached.
15. No member of British showjumping will allow a stallion for which He/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent, or rider to attend a show, compete or be prepared to compete, in any showjumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other horses/ponies, competitors and members of the public are not put at risk of injury.
15. Accumulator class 6. 1 point for first jump, 2 for second and so on. No points for a knock down or first refusal. Second refusal, elimination. Class 6 will have a "joker" fence as an alternative last fence, this will carry double points. If knocked down double points will be lost. This competition will be against the clock.
16. Please note all Lorries and trailers must have a correct in date fire extinguisher (spot checks will be made)
